From Atlanta

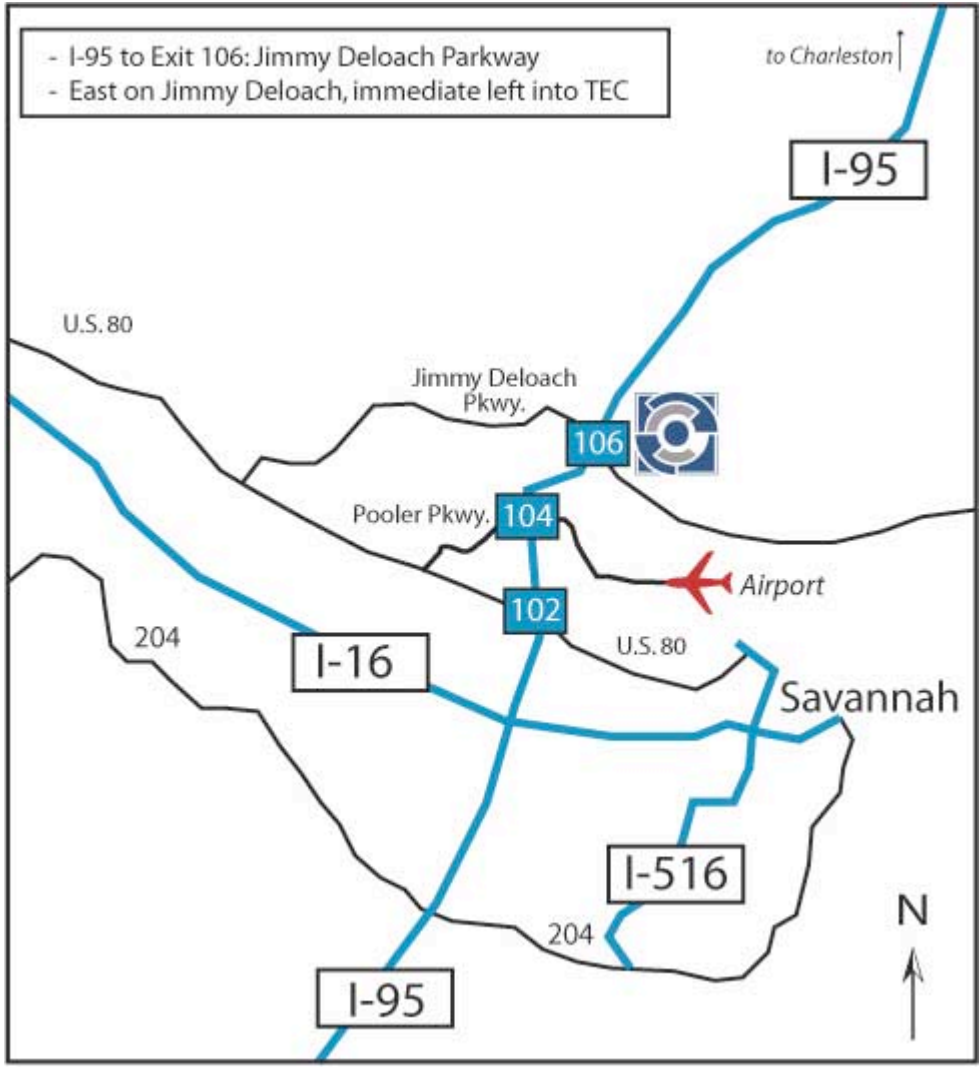
- I-75 to I-16 East
- I-16 to I-95 North
- Take Exit 106 - Jimmy Deloache Parkway (1 exit north of the airport)
- Turn right onto Jimmy Deloache Parkway
- Take first left into Crossroads Parkway
- Take a left at the stop sign onto Technology Circle

There are 3 buildings on our campus:

- EDRB is the first building on the right
- PARB is the second building on the right
- ELAB is the building behind the PARB building

From Hartsfield International Airport and Points South of Atlanta

1. Take I-75/I-85 North through downtown Atlanta to the 14th Street/10th Street exit.
2. Turn left at the second light onto 14th Street.
3. Cross over the interstate.
4. The GTRI Conference Center & ITTL Lab Building is at the top of the hill, on the left.
5. Parking is available in the parking deck that is located between the GTRI Conference Center Building and the Georgia Public Broadcasting Building.
